

## August 11, 2020 Easy Hike: Miller/Knox Regional Shoreline, Point Richmond

**Hike Description:** A summer hike location for this group with terrific views. The hike starts at **10:00 am** and is going to be approximately 4 miles with the highest elevation just under 400'. It's up and down 75'-100'- so the total is probably closer to 600'. There is shade on the bottom half until we reach the ridge line where sun protection is necessary.

**Bring:** Good hiking shoes and water during the hike. Poles are recommended. There are restrooms near the parking lot at the start of the hike.

**Directions to the hike:** From Walnut Creek take highway 24 west 12.8 miles. Take ramp on the right to 580 West 5.9 miles to Richmond. Take the Canal Street exit. Go left under the freeway, then right at the light onto Cutting. After 0.3 miles, bear left onto South Garrard. Proceed through the tunnel. Park in the first large parking lot on the right. **GPS:** 900 Dornan Drive, Richmond.

**Ride Sharing:** Not at this time as doesn't allow for social distancing.
