

2022 January 25 Hard Hike Lass Trampas Regional Wilderness, Alamo

Special note: This hike begins at 9:30 a.m.

On Tuesday (January 25) we are going to hike in the Las Trampas Regional Wilderness. This will be an out-and-back hike. We will start from the trail head at the end of Hemme Avenue in Alamo. There is a small parking lot at the trail head but no toilet facilities. We will take the Ringtail Cat Trail (single track) uphill to the Madrone Trail (fire road) and go north west for about 2 miles (we can decide to do longer or shorter at the time) and come back on the same route. It is about 3 miles each way and will take about 2 ½ - 3 hours to complete the 6 miles hike. There is a gain in elevation of approximately 900 ft. with moderate slopes and spectacular views of cities along the I-680 corridor. Put on your hiking boots and bring your hiking poles and water.

We will meet at the Hemme Avenue Trail Head at 9:15 a.m. and start at 9:30 a.m.

Hemme Avenue Trail Head Driving Directions

Take I-680 South towards Alamo.

Exit Stone Valley Road (West) and

turn right at Stone Valley Road.

Turn left at first traffic light onto Danville Boulevard.

Turn right at Hemme Avenue (First Traffic Light) and the trail head parking lot is at the end of the road

Lunch after hiking at Round Table Pizza in Alamo Plaza Shopping Center - 190 Alamo Plaza Dr., Alamo

Ride Sharing – Recommend avoiding carpooling unless all parties are vaccinated. Wearing masks is encouraged.
