

Easy Hike September 10, 2019: Benicia Historic Walk

The hike starts at **10:00 am** at the foot of 1st street in Benicia - from the Parking Lot free) opposite the old Train Station. Bathrooms available.

Hike Description: This is a 3.4 mile loop hike of historical downtown Benicia, traversing the coastline toward Glass Beach with fantastic views over the water toward Port Costa. We then take in a few historical landmarks as we cross town, and close out with a loop around the picturesque Marina.

Bring: Water, hat and sunscreen, boots or comfortable walking shoes - no poles required. Hike is mostly level.

Ridesharing: For those that would like to carpool, meet in the downtown Walnut Creek movie theater parking garage (1201 Locust St). Enter either on California Ave or Locust St. (between Olympic and Mt. Diablo.) Park on third floor and meet in the middle. **Departure time 9:15am.**

Directions to Trailhead: Take 680 to the Martinez bridge, exit on 780 and proceed to the second Benicia Exit. Go left on East 2nd street, right on Military East, and left on First Street. Then proceed to the foot of First Street.
