

February 14 2023 Easy Hike – San Francisco Waterfront

See special note below for start time

This easy hike finds us emerging from the San Francisco BART station at Embarcadero for a 4.4 mile walk along the southern waterfront. Whether it be clear skies or wild weather, this hike has some spectacular vistas. While the hike is largely an out and back foray, the final mile departs from the Embarcadero into South-of-Market downtown streets for a glimpse of interesting new and historical buildings. Then, near the return BART station, we can opt for lunch before the return ride home. Total mileage is 4.4 miles with at most 50 feet of elevation gain.

What to bring: **BART Clipper Card**, water, hiking poles if you use them.

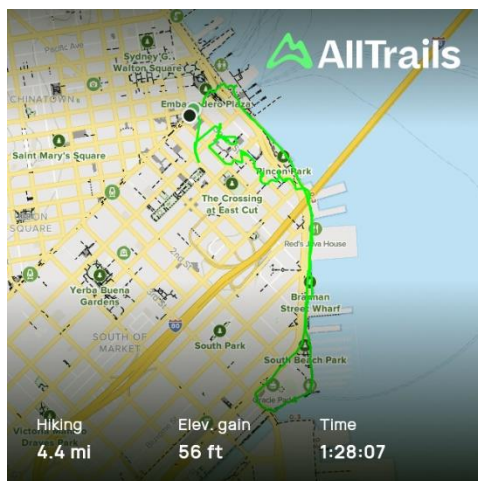
Special Note: Direction to hike: We will meet in the last BART car that arrives at the Embarcadero BART station at 9:55 a.m. per the Antioch/SF (yellow line) departure schedule below.

This is only a partial East Bay schedule (from Walnut Creek to Embarcadero) and you can catch the same train at a different station if you wish. Please consult BART schedules at BART.gov

There are restroom facilities at Ferry Building, which is our first stopping point after arriving in SF, and toward the end of our hike at the Rincon Center.

Points of interest on our hike include Oracle Park, The Hills Brothers Building, and what I call “the earthquake condominiums” pictured below.
