

February 8, 2022 - Easy hike, Lafayette Reservoir, Lafayette

Hike Description – This is an easy hike on a fully paved trail for a total of about 4 miles and 200 feet of elevation gain. From our parking spot, we first walk West along Mt. Diablo Blvd to the Lafayette Reservoir Park entrance, up Shore Trail to the main parking area. The 2.7 mile reservoir trail has some uphill parts. The hike should take about 2 hours. There is a restroom at the trailhead and along the route near the 1.5 mile marker. Always bring water and sun protection. Water is not available on the trail. The hike starts at **10:00 AM** from Mt Diablo Blvd and Village Center.

Directions to Hike - Highway 24 west to Acalanes Rd exit, turning south to Mt Diablo Blvd. Take a left and travel about one mile. We will meet on the corner of Mt. Diablo Boulevard and Village Center, Lafayette, across from the Veteran's Memorial Center. There is FREE PARKING on the South side of Mt. Diablo Boulevard.

Bring: Masks, hats, water, trekking poles if you use them.

Ride Share: Recommend avoiding carpooling unless all parties are vaccinated. Wearing masks is encouraged.
