

Lafayette Reservoir, Tuesday, June 08, 2021 Easy Hike

We will meet on the corner of Mt. Diablo Boulevard and Village Center, Lafayette, across from the Veteran's Memorial Center. There is **FREE PARKING** on the South side of Mt. Diablo Boulevard. We will walk West along Mt. Diablo to the park entrance, up Shore Trail to the parking area and proceed clockwise on the paved 2.7 mile Lakeside Natural Trail for a total of about 4 miles. The trail has some modest uphill parts. The hike should take about 2 hours. There is a restroom at the trailhead and along the route near the 1.5 mile marker. Always bring water and sun protection. Water is not available on the trail. The hike starts at **10:00 AM** from Mt Diablo Blvd and Village Center.

For those who prefer to meet at the dam and avoid the uphill segment from Mt Diablo Boulevard, given that we are only just getting back into hiking, we will meet up at **10:15** at the East end of the upper parking area and then proceed on the Shore Trail around the reservoir.

Directions: Take 24 West and exit at Mt. Diablo/Acalanes Road, exit 11. Turn left on Mt. Diablo and travel about 1.2 miles to the corner of Mt. Diablo and Village Center, across from the Veteran's Memorial Center. Free Parking is available on the South side of Mt. Diablo.

Carpooling: Recommend avoiding carpooling unless all parties are vaccinated, are from the same family or are members of no more than three families if they have been vaccinated. Wearing masks is encouraged.

Optional lunch: Not at this time.
