

March 10, 2026 Easy Hike - Nimitz Way Tilden Regional Park, 10:00 am

(Hurray! Wildcat Canyon Road from Orinda is open once again for easy access to this hike.)

Hike Description: This is a wonderful walk in Tilden Regional Park on a relatively level and gently sloped paved trail with spectacular views of San Francisco, Marin, and, in the other direction, Mt. Diablo. The walk is an out-and-back on Nimitz Way. We will go outbound 2 miles, then return on the same trail to make 4 miles total with about 100 ft elevation gain. We could shorten or lengthen the hike as we hike. We will start the hike at 10:00 AM from the Inspiration Point Staging Area. There are toilet facilities at the trail head.

Directions: Take Highway 24 exiting at Orinda, going past Orinda Village on Camino Pablo. Out of Orinda, turn left on Wildcat Canyon Road, going up the hill about 2+ miles to Inspiration Point on the right.

Bring: Hat, weather-appropriate gear, water.

Optional Rideshare: Self-arrange.

Optional Lunch: Europa Hofbrau, 62 Moraga Way, in downtown Orinda. Following the Hike, go back down Wildcat Canyon Road, turn right on Camino Pablo; at the traffic Light just past the Highway 24 underpass, turn left into downtown.
