Mitchell Canyon Easy Hike Mar 10th

Hike Description: This hike is an easy 4 miles out and back hike on the Fire Road toward Deer Flat. It's a scenic area with plenty of shade and modest elevation gains - ~200 ft AEG. Poles are optional, really not needed. BUT, bring plenty of water, as it could be quite hot.

We will meet at 10am at the Mitchell Canyon Rangers' Station at the end of Clayton Rd. in Clayton.

There are bathroom facilities and ample parking. There is a \$6 Park fee per car - modest enough when shared. Car Pooling is encouraged.

Directions: From downtown Walnut Creek, drive out Ygnacio Valley Road roughly 7 miles to Clayton Rd. Turn right, proceed exactly 1 mile to Mitchell Canyon Rd. Turn right again and follow Mitchell Canyon Rd to the end - to the Rangers' Station and parking area.

Optional Car Pool: Meet at the "movie theater parking garage" in Walnut Creek - enter either on California Blvd or Locust St (between Olympic and Mount Diablo). Meet in the center of the 3rd floor. Departure will be 9:30 am. Follow above directions to the Rangers Station. Trailhead is immediately adjacent to the parking area.
