## Hard Hike October 26, 2021: Acalanes Ridge North and South, Walnut Creek.

A 5.50 mile hike with an 1500 feet cumulative ascent. The hike starts on the Briones - Mt. Diablo Trail then connects to the Camino Verde trail, skirts the Ridge Top trail to the Concrete Arrows.

- We will make our way to the Concrete Arrows used in the 1920's to guide the US Postal Service airplanes. These markers with beacon lights were spaced all across the USA about 10 miles apart to guide the pilots. They are no longer in use but remain as a marker from 100 years ago.
- This is a Hard hike. There is some loose gravel on the up and downs but the gravel can be mostly avoided.
